

Christian Religious Instruction at Highfields State School – Information for families

Christian Religious Instruction (CRI) is provided to students of parents/caregivers who wish to have their student participate, for 30 minutes each week.

Curricula cover the fundamentals of the Christian faith beginning with creation and develops themes around God's relationship to His people and how people flourish in this relationship through Jesus Christ. Lessons are founded in the Christian Bible using bible teaching and narrative.

Students are encouraged to be with hands on activities to enhance the learning experience.

Lessons are given weekly with Infants and Lower Primary classes delivered on Tuesday afternoons between 2 and 3 pm while Upper Primary classes are scheduled on Friday morning between 9 and 10 am.

Volunteer Religious Instructors are drawn from a range of church backgrounds with most of our instructors having several years' experience delivering CRI in schools. All instructors are holders of blue cards and are committed to delivering materials in a non-sectarian and age-appropriate manner. Classes are delivered while the regular class teacher is present.
