- Facilitating release of teachers to engage in data and moderation conversations with their Line Manager and Head of Department – Curriculum
- Facilitating release of teachers to observe 'best practice' in other classrooms through Lesson Study
- Purchase of resources for the MultiLit reading intervention program
- Release of teachers to develop problem solving and inquiry aspects of P6- Mathematics program
- Salary for Community Liaison Officer
